

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2011 Wisconsin Act 90 [2011 Assembly Bill 300] Registration Plates for Dealers, Distributors, Manufacturers, and Transporters of Motor Vehicles

2011 Wisconsin Act 90 relates to registration plates for dealers, distributors, manufacturers, and transporters of motor vehicles.

Prior Wisconsin law required that each registration plate for a dealer, distributor, manufacturer, or transporter have a symbol capable of distinguishing it from other plates issued to the same entity.

Act 90 provides that the Department of Transportation is not required to include such symbols on plates when they are issued. Instead, the dealer, distributor, manufacturer, or transporter may display a sticker or decal on the plates, but such a decal or sticker must make the plate distinguishable from other plates issued to the same dealer.

Effective date: December 21, 2011.
