2013 Wisconsin Act 109 [2013 Senate Bill 295]

Information for Firearm Background Check

Act 109 creates additional means for firearms dealers to convey information for firearms background checks to the Department of Justice (DOJ).

Under current law, a firearms dealer may convey required information for a firearms background check to DOJ using a toll-free telephone number provided by DOJ.

The Act also permits a firearms dealer to convey such information using an alternative means provided by DOJ.

Effective date: Act 109 took effect on December 15, 2013.
