2013 Wisconsin Act 13 [2013 Senate Bill 67]

Registration Exemption for Amphibious Motor Vehicles

Current law exempts amphibious motor vehicles, when used for sightseeing purposes, from the general requirement that vehicles operated on highways be registered. To be eligible for this exception, the amphibious motor vehicle must be capable of carrying 10 or more passengers, registered as a boat by the Department of Natural Resources, and operated for a distance not to exceed two miles. 2013 Wisconsin Act 13 expands the distance such a vehicle may be operated under the registration exemption to five miles.

Effective date: 2013 Wisconsin Act 13 took effect on May 19, 2013.
