2013 Wisconsin Act 169 [2013 Assembly Bill 565]

Repealing the Schedule of Election Occurrences

2013 Wisconsin Act 169 is was introduced by the JLC Law Revision Committee.

Under prior law, subch II of ch. 10, Stats., contained a chronologically arranged schedule of election occurrences. The statutes provided that the schedule in subchapter II was not to be considered substantive law. In addition, the Legislative Reference Bureau was required to update the schedule in response to changes to the laws relating to elections and include the updates in a correction bill. Act 169 repeals the subchapter.
