

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 325 [2013 Assembly Bill 824]

Enforcement of Disabled Parking Space Violations

Under current law, no person may park, stop, or leave standing any vehicle upon any portion of a street, highway, or parking facility reserved for vehicles displaying special registration plates or a special identification card designating the vehicle as a vehicle used by a physically disabled person. Current law also prohibits a person from obstructing, blocking, or otherwise limiting the use of any space or access aisle reserved for physically disabled persons to use.

2013 Wisconsin Act 325 provides that a disabled parking space violation may be enforced by a person who is employed by a city, village, town, or county, and is designated by that city, village, town, or county to enforce disabled parking space violations.
