2013 Wisconsin Act 329 [Assembly Bill 260]

Talent Incentive Grant Program

2013 Wisconsin Act 329 makes changes to the Talent Incentive Grant Program. The Higher Educational Aids Board (HEAB) awards talent incentive grants to the most financially needy and educationally disadvantaged Wisconsin resident students enrolled at public and private nonprofit institutions of higher education in Wisconsin. HEAB may not award a talent incentive grant to the same student for more than 10 semesters.

The Act specifies that a student need not maintain continuous enrollment for 10 semesters in order to remain eligible for a talent incentive grant. Under the Act, HEAB may award a talent incentive grant to the same student for up to 10 semesters, whether or not consecutive, but may not award a talent incentive grant to the same student more than six years after the initial grant is awarded to that student.

Effective date: April 25, 2014.
