

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 354 [2013 Senate Bill 311]

Certification to Administer Nitrous Oxide Inhalation Anesthesia

Under current law, the Dentistry Examining Board (DEB) licenses dental hygienists in Wisconsin, and certifies qualified dental hygienists to administer a local anesthesia.

2013 Wisconsin Act 354 requires the DEB to grant a certificate to administer nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia to a dental hygienist who is licensed by the board and who satisfies certain educational requirements that the Act directs the board to establish by rule. Under the Act, the certificate, once issued, remains in effect while the dental hygienist holds a valid license to practice dental hygiene in Wisconsin, unless the DEB suspends or revokes the certificate.

Effective date: November 1, 2014.
