

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 366 [2013 Assembly Bill 715]

Cancellation of Motor Vehicle Title or Registration for Fraud

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must cancel a vehicle's title or registration whenever DOT discovers fraud on DOT with respect to the title or registration. 2013 Wisconsin Act 366 requires DOT to also cancel a vehicle's title or registration whenever DOT discovers fraud on an agent of DOT, such as a motor vehicle dealer, that processes title and registration applications for transmittal to DOT.
