

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

## 2013 Wisconsin Act 367 [2013 Assembly Bill 716]

**Expiration of Driver's Licenses Issued After Cancellation** 

The Department of Transportation (DOT) may cancel vehicle operator's licenses for a variety of reasons. Generally, when a person's license has been canceled, he or she may apply for a new license at any time. Under prior law, a license issued after cancellation expired two years from the date of the applicant's next birthday.

Under 2013 Wisconsin Act 367, a license issued after cancellation expires on the expiration date of the license the applicant held at the time of cancellation.

*Effective date:* 2013 Wisconsin Act 367 took effect on April 25, 2014, and first applies to applications for operators' licenses received on that date.
