2013 Wisconsin Act 379 [2013 Assembly Bill 17]

Restoration of Birth Certificate After Adoption

2013 Wisconsin Act 379 relates to the restoration of information from an original birth certificate after adoption.

The Act creates a procedure to allow a person who has been adopted to ask a court for a restored birth certificate that shows the birth parents' names, and the time and hospital of the birth. A court must order the preparation of a restored birth certificate unless either living birth parent objects or the person had an opportunity at the time of the adoption to request that a birth certificate reflecting the adoption not be ordered.

The Act specifies that a restoration of the information from an original birth certificate does not alter a person's current legal relationships with the adoptive and birth parents, and does not authorize a legal name change.

Effective date: 2013 Wisconsin Act 379 is effective April 25, 2014.
