2013 Wisconsin Act 94 [2013 Senate Bill 240]

Knowledge Tests for CDL Applicants who hold a Military CDL

Under prior law, veterans holding a military commercial driver license (CDL) were able to convert it to a Wisconsin CDL without taking the knowledge and skills tests that other applicants must take. This is similar to how Wisconsin treats the application of a person holding a CDL from another jurisdiction.

To comply with federal law, the Act requires a person holding a military CDL to take applicable knowledge tests to obtain a Wisconsin CDL, unless the applicant is exempt from, or eligible for a waiver of, the knowledge tests under federal law.

Effective date and initial applicability: The Act took effect on December 15, 2013 and first applies to applications for commercial driver licenses received by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation on that date.
