

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 229 [2015 Senate Bill 391]

Training Period for Election Officials; Term of Office for Members of Boards of Canvassers

2015 Wisconsin Act 229 makes changes to the period during which an election official must attend training and to the term of office for members of boards of canvassers.

TRAINING PERIOD FOR ELECTION OFFICIALS

Under Wisconsin law, each election official must attend training every two years.

The Act specifies a two-year period during which an election official must attend training. Specifically, the Act requires an election official to attend training during the period beginning on January 1 of each even-numbered year and ending on December 31 of the following year.

TERM OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF BOARDS OF CANVASSERS

Under Wisconsin law, the members of boards of canvassers serve for two-year terms. Under prior law, the term commenced on January 1 of each **odd-numbered year**.

The Act changes the date on which the term of office for members of boards of canvassers commences. Under the Act, the two-year term of office commences on January 1 of each **even-numbered year**. In addition, under the Act, a member of a board of canvassers appointed to serve a two-year term ending on December 31, 2016, serves until December 31, 2017.
