## 2015 Wisconsin Act 234 [2015 Senate Bill 462]

## Driver License Suspension for Failure to Pay Fines

Previous law allowed a court to suspend the operating privilege of a person for up to two years if the person failed to pay a monetary judgment entered against the individual. 2015 Wisconsin Act 234 reduced the maximum time for which a person's operating privilege may be suspended for this reason from two years to one year.
