

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 362 [2015 Senate Bill 275]

Parking Spaces Reserved for Persons With Physical Disabilities

Generally, a person may not stop a vehicle in a disabled parking space unless the vehicle displays special disabled motor vehicle registration plates or a disabled parking card obtained from the Department of Transportation (DOT), along with other conditions. 2015 Wisconsin Act 362 allows a taxicab driver to stop in a disabled parking space to load a passenger who has been issued a disabled parking card. The passenger must provide the disabled parking card number to the taxicab service when arranging for the transportation and, at pickup, must present to the taxi driver the disabled parking card and the letter from DOT which accompanied the card when it was issued to the passenger. This exception does not apply if there is another suitable, available loading zone for loading the passenger.
