

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 42 [2015 Assembly Bill 28]

## Nonfunctioning or Malfunctioning Traffic Control Signals

## **BACKGROUND**

Current law requires traffic controlled by traffic control signals exhibiting different colored lights to perform certain actions based upon the color of light that is exhibited by the signal and whether the light displayed by the signal is flashing. Statutes also require traffic to stop at an official stop sign. [ss. 346.37 (1), 346.39, and 346.46, Stats.]

## 2015 WISCONSIN ACT 42

The Act adds a new requirement specifying that, if a traffic control signal suffers a loss of power or otherwise malfunctions so that the traffic control signal does not exhibit any color of light, traffic must proceed as if the traffic control signal were a stop sign.
