2017 Wisconsin Act 117
[2017 Senate Bill 128]

Allowing Circuit Court Commissioners to Issue Search Warrants for Certain Civil Violations

Circuit court commissioners are granted certain statutory powers, including the authority, in criminal matters, to issue search warrants. Under current law, first-offense operating while intoxicated (OWI) is generally a civil offense, not a crime. 2015 Wisconsin Act 183 authorized a court to issue a warrant, upon probable cause, for the search or seizure of anything that is the fruit of or has been used in the commission of an OWI offense, whether criminal or noncriminal. 2017 Wisconsin Act 117 extends this authority to circuit court commissioners.
