2017 Wisconsin Act 158 [2017 Assembly Bill 330]

Rule Promulgation by Certain Boards and Commissions

2017 Wisconsin Act 158 prohibits certain state boards and commissions from promulgating rules, unless they are specifically authorized to do so by subsequent legislation. Specifically, the prohibition applies to boards, affiliated credentialing boards, examining boards, and commissions, as defined by statute, if the relevant board or commission has not taken any action with respect to rule promulgation in at least 10 years.
