## 2017 Wisconsin Act 229 [2017 Senate Bill 360]

## Registration Plates for Firefighters and Emergency Medical Services Practitioners and Responders

Current law enumerates various authorized groups whose members may obtain a special registration plate from the Department of Transportation (DOT). Among the authorized groups are: (1) firefighters and surviving spouses of firefighters who die in the line of duty; and (2) persons who are licensed as emergency service practitioners or emergency medical responders (collectively, EMS).

For most special registration plates, DOT must charge a \$15 fee, in addition to the applicable annual vehicle registration fee, to issue or reissue the plates. 2017 Wisconsin Act 229 provides that the additional \$15 does not apply to firefighter and EMS plates.

*Effective date:* The elimination of the additional \$15 fee for firefighter and EMS plates initially applies to applications for registration received by DOT on the Act's effective date, which is April 5, 2018.
