## 2017 Wisconsin Act 48 [2017 Senate Bill 79]

## Copying of Birth Certificates for Passport Applications

Generally, Wisconsin Statutes prohibit the copying of vital records, including copying of birth certificates. For county clerks or clerks of court who process passport applications, 2017 Wisconsin Act 48 creates an exception to this prohibition to allow a county clerk or clerk of court to copy a birth certificate for submission with a passport application. A copy made under this exception must be marked "FOR PASSPORT USE ONLY."
