2017 Wisconsin Act 50 [2017 Senate Bill 94]

Notice of City Council Special Meetings

2017 Wisconsin Act 50 revises the manner in which a mayor of a city may convene a special meeting of the city council. Under the Act, a mayor may call a special meeting by notifying city council members in a manner likely to give each member notice of the meeting. Prior to Act 50, a mayor was required to provide written notice that was delivered personally to each member or left at the member's usual abode. Both before and after Act 50, the notice must be provided at least six hours before the meeting.
