**2019 Wisconsin Act 131** [2019 Assembly Bill 437]

Electronic Health Records at Recreational and Educational Camps

Under the administrative code, the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) currently requires that health services staff at recreational and educational camps keep records of medications administered and treatments provided to campers and staff members in a bound book with preprinted page numbers.

2019 Wisconsin Act 131 provides that, if DATCP requires that such records be maintained, then DATCP must allow them to be made and maintained electronically if done in a system that documents each change to the health record and that does not allow previous changes to the health record to be edited or deleted.
