

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2019 Wisconsin Act 3 [2019 Senate Bill 1] Designating and Marking the Michael G. Ellis Memorial Interchange

2019 Wisconsin Act 3 requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to designate the interchange of Interstate 41, U.S. Highway 10, and State Highway 441 in Winnebago County as the Michael G. Ellis Memorial Interchange. The act also directs DOT to erect markers to clearly identify this interchange as the Michael G. Ellis Memorial Interchange upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, including any county, city, village, or town. No state funds may be expended for the erection or maintenance of the markers, except for contributions received from interested parties for this purpose.

Effective date: 2019 Wisconsin Act 3 took effect on May 3, 2019.
