Assembly Bill 290 contains a number of provisions prohibiting certain conduct with respect to airbags and previously deployed airbags. The provision affected by Assembly Amendment 1 prohibits a person, either personally or through an agent, from selling, installing, reinstalling, or distributing any previously deployed airbag.

Assembly Amendment 1 provides that the above provision does not apply to the sale of a motor vehicle with a previously deployed airbag unless the deployment is concealed or disguised.

The Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 and passage of Assembly Bill 290, as amended, both by votes of Ayes, 13, Noes, 0, on April 19, 2001.
