

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2001 Assembly Bill 7	Assembly Amendment 1

*Current law* authorizes the Department of Commerce to promulgate rules regarding the storage and handling of anhydrous ammonia. Any person who violates these rules may be required to forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$100.

Assembly Bill 7 creates new penalties that apply to certain violations of the anhydrous ammonia storage rules and creates new penalties relating to anhydrous ammonia. Assembly Bill 7 also creates an exemption from civil liability for a person who owns or uses anhydrous ammonia equipment if any injuries occur due to acts or omissions by persons who violate the prohibitions in the bill. Assembly Bill 7 has a delayed effective date, and would take effect on the first day of the sixth month beginning after publication.

Assembly Amendment 1 deletes the delayed effective date, so that the bill would take effect on the day after publication.
