Assembly Substitute Amendment 1

2003 Assembly Bill 563 authorizes a city or village in Milwaukee County to establish jointly with another city or village a multiple municipal local health department under ch. 251, Stats. This provision continues to be included in the substitute amendment.

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 additionally authorizes a city with an existing city health department to establish in concert with another city in the same county with an existing city health department a city-city health department under ch. 251. Based on available information, it appears that Winnebago County is currently the only county outside of Milwaukee County with more than one existing city health department (there are three city health departments in that county).

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 was offered by the Assembly Committee on Urban and Local Affairs. The committee recommended adoption of the substitute amendment by a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 0.
