## 2003 Assembly Bill 724

## Assembly Amendment 1

**Assembly Bill 724** creates a statutory section [s. 347.482, Stats.], relating to child seating requirements in a motor vehicle. This new section prohibits any person from operating a motor vehicle unless he or she reasonably believes that each child being transported who is at least four years old but less than 12 years old is seated in a designated seating position as prescribed in the section. A person who violates these requirements is subject to a forfeiture of \$10.

**Assembly Amendment 1** deletes this new section relating to child seating requirements (i.e., deletes that part of the bill creating s. 347.482, Stats.

## **Legislative History**

On January 21, 2003, the Assembly Committee on Highway Safety voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1, offered by the committee, by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0, and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 724, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 7; Noes, 1.
