

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2003 Senate Bill 105

Assembly Amendment 1

Senate Bill 105 provides that whenever a person is convicted or adjudicated delinquent for making a bomb scare involving the threatened destruction of property owned or leased by the state or any political subdivision of the state or of school premises, knowingly possessing a firearm in a school zone, or discharging or attempting to discharge a firearm in a school zone, the court *must* suspend the person's driver's license for two years.

Assembly Amendment 1 provides that the court may suspend such a person's driver's license.

The Assembly Committee on Criminal Justice voted to recommend adoption of the amendment on a votes of Ayes 13; Noes 0; and voted to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes 13; Noes 0; on March 10, 2004.
