

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

Under current law, members of a nonprofit corporation may hold a meeting in person or by telephone conference and may settle issues by a vote in person or by written ballot. In addition, under certain circumstances, members can approve actions without a meeting by providing written consent. 2003 Senate Bill 485 allows members of a nonprofit corporation to hold meetings and settle issues by electronic communication or electronic ballot. Senate Amendment 1 allows members of a nonprofit corporation to provide their written consent to actions by electronic means.

On February 26, 2004, the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Financial Institutions, and Insurance adopted Senate Amendment 1 by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
