Assembly Amendment 1 is based on recommendations made by the state Department of Justice. Item 1 of the amendment revises reference to pseudoephedrine in the listing of Schedule V controlled substances under ch. 961, Stats., for consistency with changes made in related statutes by Assembly Bill 1090. Items 2, 3, and 4 of Assembly Amendment 1 clarify that the affected prohibitions relating to pseudoephedrine apply to more than 7.5 grams of pseudoephedrine "contained in a pseudoephedrine product."

<u>Legislative History</u>

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representatives Rhoades and Sherman. The Assembly Committee on Judiciary recommended adoption of the amendment by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0, and recommended passage of the proposal, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
