## 2005 Assembly Bill 150

## Assembly Substitute Amendment 1

Current law places a cap on the number of state park campsites that may have electric receptacles. Under this statute, not more than 25% of all state park campsites may have electric receptacles.

Assembly Bill 150 changes this cap so that not more than 50% of all state park campsites may have electric receptacles.

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 changes the statewide cap so that not more than 30% of all state park campsites may have electric receptacles. In addition, the substitute amendment adds a requirement that not more than 50% of the campsites in any one state park may have electric receptacles.

## Legislative History

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 was recommended for adoption by the Assembly Committee on Natural Resources on November 16, 2005 on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0. The committee voted to recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 3.
