

# WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

## 2005 Assembly Bill 726

## **Assembly Amendment 1**

Assembly Bill 726 authorizes a city, village, town, county, school district, or technical college district that has purchased motor vehicle fuel for its own use to file a claim with the Department of Revenue (DOR) and receive a refund for the amount of motor vehicle tax paid by the entity on the purchase of the fuel. In addition, a person who transports students to and from school activities pursuant to a contract with a school district is authorized to file a claim with DOR and receive a refund.

### Assembly Amendment 1:

- 1. Clarifies that the proposal only applies to cities, villages, towns, counties, school districts, or technical college districts located in this state.
- 2. Extends the refund provision to alternate fuels.
- 3. Provides that, if enacted, the proposal takes effect on the first day of the third month beginning after publication (to allow necessary changes to forms and computer programs).

### **Legislative History**

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Ballweg. The amendment was recommended for adoption by the Assembly Committee on Urban and Local Affairs by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0. The proposal was recommended for passage, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
