

# WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

## **2005 Senate Bill 162**

## Senate Amendment 1

**2005 Senate Bill 162** creates a 16-member Council on Transportation Infrastructure in the Department of Transportation. These 16 members include, among others:

- 1. **Three** Representatives of the Wisconsin State Assembly, appointed as are the members of Assembly standing committees, who serve on any Assembly standing committee dealing with transportation matters.
- 2. Two Senators from the Wisconsin State Senate appointed as are the members of Senate standing committees who serve on any Senate standing committee dealing with transportation matters.

### **Senate Amendment 1** amends these provisions in the bill to:

- 1. Change the number of Representatives from three to two. This changes from 16 to 15 (an odd number) the total number of members on the Council.
- 2. Specify that, with reference to the Representatives and Senators appointed to the Council, one must be a member of the majority party and one must be a member of the minority party.

#### Legislative History

On February 1, 2006, the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Transportation held an executive session on the bill. The committee adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes 1, and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes 4; Noes 1.
