Senate Joint Resolution 33 prohibits the Governor, in exercising the Governor's partial veto authority, from creating a new sentence by combining parts of two or more sentences of the enrolled bill.

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 provides, instead, that the Governor, in exercising the partial veto authority, may not reject any individual word in a sentence of the enrolled bill unless the entire sentence is rejected.

Legislative History

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 was offered by Representatives Gundrum and Friske. The amendment was recommended for adoption by the Assembly Committee on Judiciary by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 2. The joint resolution, as amended, was recommended for concurrence by the Assembly Committee on Judiciary by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 2.
