Special Session Senate Bill 1 provides in part that no person may make a contribution to an incumbent partisan state elective official or a candidate for a partisan state office during the period beginning on the date of introduction of the Executive Budget Bill and ending on the date of enactment of the Biennial Budget Act.

Senate Amendment 1 provides that the period during which a contribution may not be made will begin on January 1 of each odd-numbered year.

Legislative History

On February 28, 2008, the Senate Committee on Campaign Finance Reform, Rural Issues and Information Technology introduced and adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 4; Noes, 0. On the same date, the committee recommended passage of Special Session Senate Bill 1, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 1.
