2007 Assembly Bill 302

Assembly Amendment 1

Assembly Bill 302 directs the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to allow the use of golf carts by persons age 16 and over in Governor Tommy G. Thompson Centennial State Park and the Peshtigo River State Forest. The bill requires the DNR to write administrative rules which specify when and where golf carts may be used in the state park and the state forest. The DNR rules must limit the use of golf carts to approximately the same time and places as golf carts were used before the state park and state forest were acquired by the state.

Assembly Amendment 1 specifies instead that the DNR rules must allow golf carts to be used for at least the same hours and in at least the same places as golf carts were used before the state park and state forest were acquired by the state.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by the Assembly Committee on Rural Economic Development on July 25, 2007. On the same date, the committee recommended adoption of the amendment by unanimous consent and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 302, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 0.

On October 24, 2007, the Assembly adopted Assembly Amendment 1 on a voice vote, and passed Assembly Bill 302, as amended, also on a voice vote.
