### **Assembly Amendment 1 to 2007 Assembly Bill 718**

Under current law, certain actions of a local governmental unit that affect land use must be consistent with that local governmental unit's comprehensive plan, beginning on January 1, 2010. 2007 Assembly Bill 718 would delay this requirement for five years, until January 1, 2015. Assembly Amendment 1 would instead delay this requirement for three years, until January 1, 2013.

### **Legislative History**

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Mary Williams and adopted by the Assembly by a voice vote. Assembly Bill 718, as amended, was adopted by the Assembly by a vote of Ayes, 77; Noes, 20.
