

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

Assembly Amendment 1

Assembly Bill 164 grants to a relative, other than a parent, in whose home a child is placed the same procedural rights relating to notice of intent to remove a child from the home and review of decisions or orders involving the placement and care of the child that are granted a foster parent under current law.

Assembly Amendment 1 amends the bill to reflect changes made to the statutes by 2009 Wisconsin Act 28 (the Biennial Budget Bill). The amendment retains the original bill's provisions granting the same procedural rights of notice of intent to remove a child from the home, to a relative other than a parent.

Legislative History

On August 19, 2009, the Assembly Committee on Children and Families introduced Assembly Amendment 1 by unanimous consent; recommended adoption of the amendment by a vote of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
