Senate Amendment 1 to 2009 Senate Bill 17:

- 1. Specifies that instead of the specific listing of the Wisconsin National Guard units for which the special decal is available (as in the bill), the Department of Military Affairs (DMA) must, by rule, identify each National Guard unit for which a decal is available.
- 2. Provides for emergency rule-making for the DMA relating to designating these units.
- 3. Provides that instead of the decal being free of charge (as in the bill), the Department of Transportation must charge a fee of \$20 for each decal provided to an applicant.
- 4. Specifies that the general effective date of the bill remains the same (the first day of the fourth month after enactment), but (a) the new provisions relating to rule-making take effect immediately after enactment; and (b) the emergency rule-making must be completed by the first day of the fourth month after enactment.

Legislative History

At an Executive Session on September 30, 2009, the Senate Committee on Transportation, Tourism, Forestry, and Natural Resources, the committee voted to adopt Senate Amendment 1 to the bill (offered by Senator Hansen) and to recommend passage of the bill, as so amended, both on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
