Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 2009 Senate Bill 215 provides a property tax exemption for trail groomers owned by a snowmobile club or all-terrain vehicle club this is a nonprofit organization (i.e., is exempt from taxation under s. 501 (c) (3), (4), or (7) of the Internal Revenue Code).

The substitute amendment provides for an initial applicability date: the bill, if enacted into law, first applies to the property tax assessments as of January 1, 2009.

Legislative History

2009 Senate Bill 215, as amended by the Senate (adoption of Senate Substitute Amendment 1), passed the Senate on a vote of Ayes, 31; Noes, 1. The bill was then referred to the Assembly Committee on Tourism, Recreation and State Properties. At an executive session on November 3, 2009, that committee recommended concurrence in the bill, as passed by the Senate, on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
