Senate Amendment 1

In general, an animal rendering or processing plant, which includes a slaughtering establishment, may not be constructed within 1/8 mile of a dwelling or business building, although an existing rendering or processing plant may continue to operate if a dwelling or business building is constructed within 1/8 mile of it.

2009 Senate Bill 268 specifies that a person may establish or expand a rendering or processing plant within 1/8 mile of a dwelling or business building with the approval of the city, village, or town in which it would be located.

Senate Amendment 1 limits the bill to apply only if animals will not be slaughtered in the plant and only animal parts will be processed in the plant.

Legislative History

On January 13, 2010, the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Higher Education voted to introduce Senate Amendment 1 to Senate Bill 268, recommend adoption of the amendment, and recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 5; and Noes, 0.
