2009 Senate Bill 536 relates to programs to promote the use of fresh, locally produced foods in schools.

The *bill* applies to locally produced fresh fruits and vegetables and other nutritious, locally produced foods. *Senate Amendment 1* expands the bill to apply also to locally produced dairy products.

Under the *bill*, the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) makes grants to school districts, among other entities. *Senate Amendment 2* specifies that the DATCP must coordinate with the Department of Public Instruction in making grants to school districts.

Legislative History

On April 2, 2010, the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Higher Education voted to recommend adoption of Senate Amendments 1 and 2 on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0, and voted to recommend passage of Senate Bill 536, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.

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
