

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

## 2009 Senate Bill 564 Senate Amendment 1 Memo published: April 15, 2010 Contact: Don Salm, Senior Staff Attorney (266-8540)

Under **current law**, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals, groups, or events.

**Senate Bill 564** directs the Department of Transportation to designate and, upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, mark a portion of the route of STH 50 in Kenosha County as the "LeRoy and Lynn Copen Memorial Highway" in recognition and appreciation of their legacy of community service.

**Senate Amendment 1** to the bill substitutes "Lee" for "Leroy" wherever "Leroy" appears in the bill. Mr. Copen's name was "Lee Copen" and not "Leroy Copen."

## Legislative History

At an executive session on April 1, 2010, the Senate Committee on Transportation, Tourism, Forestry and Natural Resources voted to adopt Senate Amendment 1 and to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, both on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
