2013 Senate Bill 274 increases the appropriation for the vocational rehabilitation program, a joint federal-state program administered by the Department of Workforce Development (DWD), by \$1,826,200 for fiscal year 2013-14 and by \$2,030,700 for fiscal year 2014-15. The bill also increases the positions authorized for DWD to provide vocational rehabilitation services.

Senate Amendment 1 increases the appropriation for the vocational rehabilitation program, above the amount provided in current law, by \$2,108,900 for fiscal year 2013-14 and by \$2,096,700 for fiscal year 2014-15.

Bill History

Senate Amendment 1 was offered by the Joint Committee on Finance. On October 16, 2013, the Joint Committee on Finance recommended adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 16; Noes, 0.
