Senate Amendments 1 and 2

Under **2013 Senate Bill 299**, a town located on Madeline Island or Washington Island is exempt from: (1) the county property tax levy related to operating or maintaining, or providing services to, an airport; or (2) for public health or economic development services, if the town levies a tax for the same purposes in an amount proportionate to the county levy for those purposes.

Senate Amendment 1 establishes a September 1st deadline for a town to apply to the county for such treatment and provides a 30-day window for the county to render a decision on the application and inform the town. The amendment also delays the initial applicability of the bill for one year.

Senate Amendment 2 eliminates towns on Washington Island from treatment under bill.

Bill History

Senator Jauch offered Senate Amendments 1 and 2. On January 15, 2014, the Senate Committee on Workforce Development, Forestry, Mining, and Revenue voted to recommend adoption of Senate Amendments 1 and 2 and to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
