

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2013 Senate Bill 344 (the bill) requires an owner to disclose on a real estate condition report or vacant land disclosure report whether the owner has notice or knowledge that a dam is located on the property or that ownership of a dam that is collectively owned by a homeowner association, lake district, or other group runs with the property.

The bill also requires both reports to state that if an owner has indicated that a dam is located on the property or ownership of a dam runs with the property, the prospective buyer should contact the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to find out if dam transfer requirements apply.

Senate Amendment 1 specifies that a prospective buyer should contact the DNR to find out if dam transfer requirements *or agency orders* apply.

## **BILL HISTORY**

On January 30, 2014, the Senate Committee on Insurance and Housing voted to recommend adoption of the amendment, and passage of the bill, as amended, on successive votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.

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
