

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2013 Senate Bill 365 relates to coverage of certain individuals engaged in sales activity outside a permanent retail establishment under the unemployment insurance law.

## **2013 Senate Bill 365**

Senate Bill 365 revises the unemployment insurance exemption for individuals commonly referred to as "direct sellers." The bill provides that such a person is exempt if the person is engaged in selling or soliciting the sale of consumer products while in a home or in another setting outside of a permanent retail establishment, and substantially all of the person's pay for the work is directly related to the sales or other output.

## Senate Amendment 1

Senate Amendment 1 specifies that the pay for "other output" must be related to the sales.

## Bill History

On November 5, 2013, the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Labor adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
