Senate Substitute Amendment 1

Under **2013 Senate Bill 514**, the owner of a snowmobile that is at least 30 years old at the time that the owner applies for registration may register the snowmobile with the Department of Natural Resources as an antique snowmobile. Such a registered snowmobile is exempt from reregistration while under the same ownership.

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 allows registration of snowmobiles as antique snowmobiles, if they are at least 35 years old, for an initial fee of \$20 and a renewal fee of \$5 every two years. The substitute amendment allows someone who has already applied for registration of a snowmobile that is at least 35 years old before this bill becomes law to renew that registration for \$5.

Bill History

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 was offered by Senator Tiffany. On March 18, 2014, the Senate Committee on Transportation, Public Safety and Veterans and Military Affairs recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Senate Bill 514, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
