2015 SENATE BILL 274

Senate Bill 274 removes the requirement that a consumer reporting to a vehicle manufacturer that a new vehicle does not conform to an applicable express warranty must make the report on a form prescribed by the Department of Transportation.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 makes the removal of this requirement retroactive to March 1, 2014, which is when the current reporting requirement initially took effect.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Petrowski offered Senate Amendment 1 on October 27, 2015. On January 7, 2016, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Veterans Affairs voted unanimously to recommend adoption Senate Amendment 1 and passage of Senate Bill 274, as amended.
