2017 SPECIAL SESSION ASSEMBLY BILL 11

Special Session Assembly Bill 11 requires the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to establish a mental health training support program. Under the program, DPI must provide school district staff and independent charter school instructional staff with training on screening, brief intervention, and referral to treatment (commonly called SBIRT). The bill creates a new appropriation, providing \$100,000 in 2017-18 and \$100,000 in 2018-19 to DPI for the training program.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 (AA 1) increases the appropriation from \$100,000 each year to \$200,000 each year.

BILL HISTORY

AA 1 was offered by Representative Nygren. On March 9, 2017, the Assembly Committee on Education recommended adoption of AA 1 on a vote of Ayes, 15; Noes, 0, and passage of Special Session Assembly Bill 11, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 16; Noes, 0.
