2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 289

Assembly Bill 289 would create an individual income tax exemption for the value of any Olympic medal won by an individual in Olympic competition, as well as any amount of income received by an individual from the U.S. Olympic Committee because the individual won an Olympic medal.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 would extend the income tax exemption to the value of medals won and payments received in relation to Paralympic and Special Olympics competition.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Bill 289 was introduced by Representative Sanfelippo on May 1, 2017. On June 22, 2017, Representative Sanfelippo offered Assembly Amendment 1. On June 29, 2017, the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 and passage of Assembly Bill 289, as amended, on consecutive votes of Ayes, 11; Noes, 0.
